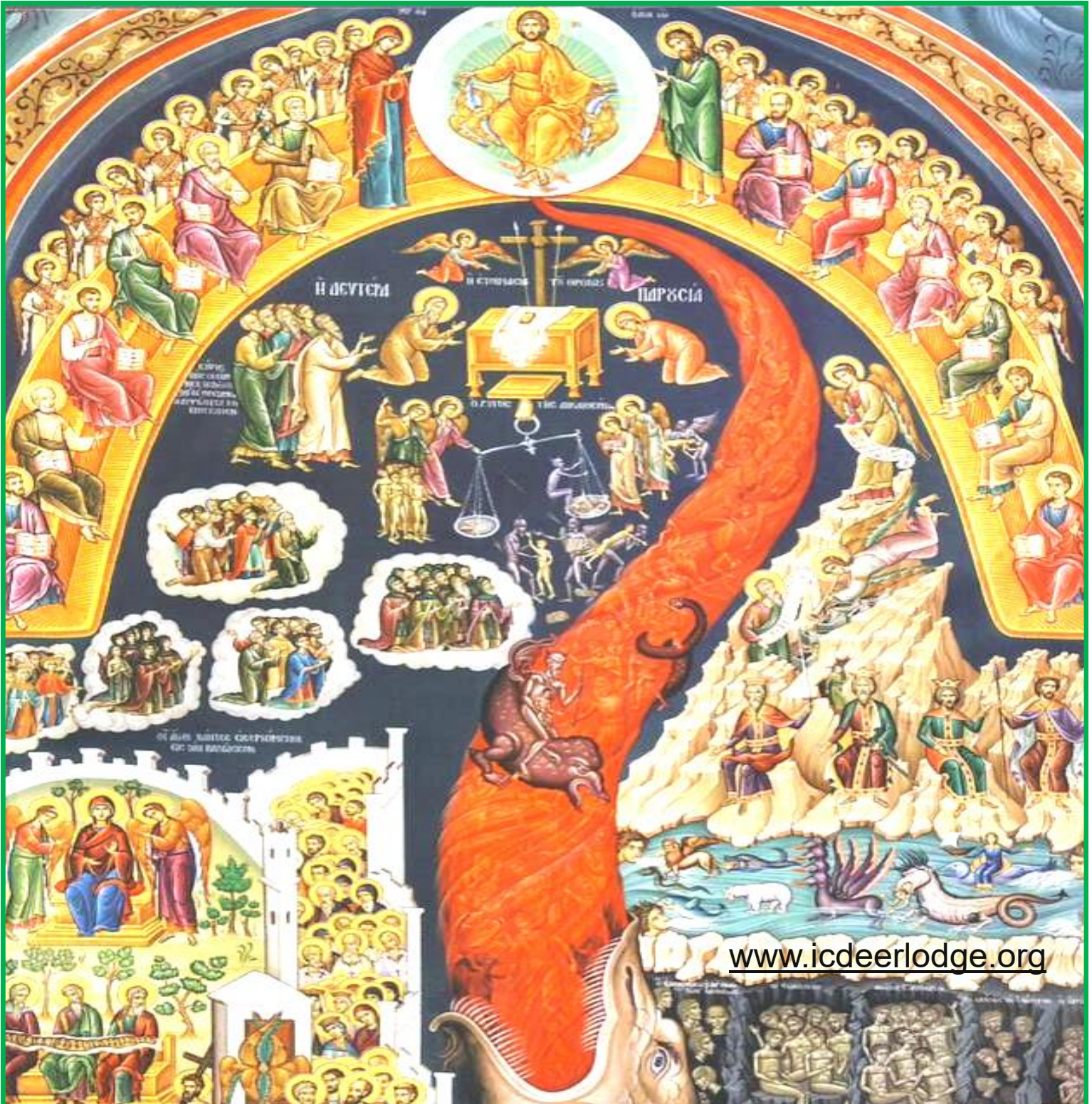

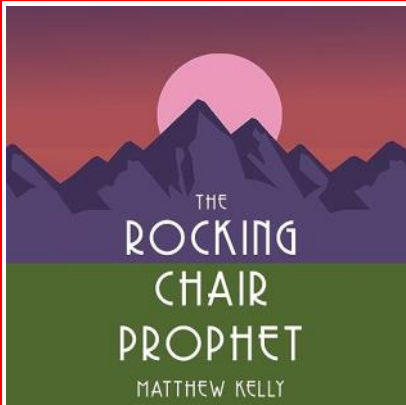

A CAMPAIGN FOR CATHOLIC LIFE

This Sunday is Commitment Sunday when we officially close out our Capital Campaign pilot project. We have done very well raising 159% of our goal of \$259,000 for a total of \$412,310 pledged over the next 5 years. This means that Immaculate Conception will receive \$210,686 for our church to spend on Evangelization, Endowments and Capital projects. St. Theodore hit 427% of their goal of \$20,224 for a total of \$86,400. They will have \$66,176 to spend on their projects and programs. There will still likely be a few pledges that come in after the deadline that will be reported on later. Thank You to everyone for your outstanding generosity.

The roof is finished and we will list the house next week with a realtor after the Thanksgiving Holiday.

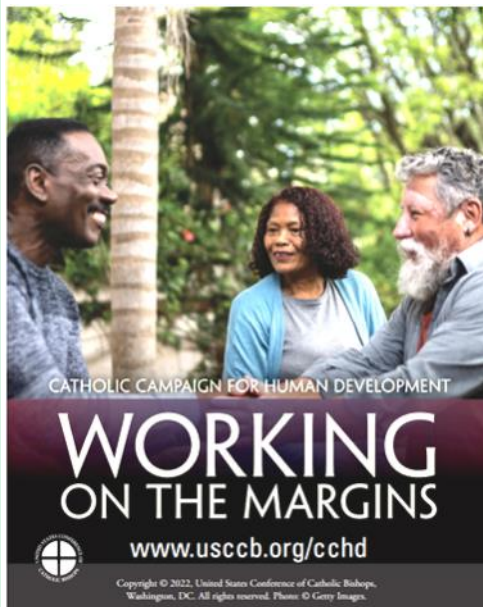


Beautiful Eucharist

SACRAMENTAL INFORMATION

Infant Baptism: Parents must be registered & active members of this parish or of another parish with family here in the parish (i.e., parents). Letter of permission from Pastor if parents are from outside the parish. Two Godparents who are registered and active members of their parish, one male and one female. Contact the Pastor before infant's due date to arrange date and time.

Holy Matrimony: Couples discerning this sacrament should contact the Pastor immediately after becoming engaged. NOTE: the diocese requires a minimum of 6 months advance notice regarding the intention to marry. Couples wishing to marry in the parish must be registered and active members of the parish, or individuals who have moved away whose parents are still active in the parish. Couples from other parishes must obtain a letter of permission to marry outside of their own parish.

Anointing of the Sick: Individuals who have been diagnosed as terminally or gravely ill or are preparing for invasive surgery should request this sacrament. Confession ordinarily proceeds receiving the sacrament of the sick, call the church office at 846-4114 to make arrangements.

Adult Confirmation, Adult Baptism (RCIA), and Adult Reception into Full Communion with the Church: If you, a family member, or a friend has not received the sacrament of confirmation, or are interested in being baptized into the Faith, or received into full communion with the Church, please contact the Pastor. Process will be discerned on an individual basis based on preparedness.
