


### Parish Registration

For the past 2 years we have only added 2 families to our parish directory even though we have a number of new faces in the pews. If you are regularly attending services at Immaculate Conception or St. Theodore Mission, we would ask that you fill out a registration form for your family. Having good demographic information about our parishioners allows us to more accurately plan for future services and programs based on ages and numbers of people we serve. We won't share this information with anyone else, it is strictly for our internal use.

### Convent Remodel Capital Improvement Campaign.

We have received \$100,000 in challenge grants from generous donors to help fund our Convent Remodel project. We have estimated the initial cost of the remodel project to be \$200,000. If each of our 120 registered families could commit to donating \$833 or \$16/week for a year, we would be able to raise the \$100,000 to double our money with the matching grant. We know for some families that this would be a stretch, but for others maybe even more would be possible. Please give some prayerful consideration to what your family can afford to donate to help with this campaign. Pledge envelopes are in the back of the Church on the tables.



On Monday, June 18<sup>th</sup>, we will have a group of special guests spending the night in the St. Mary's Center. They are biking their way from the Pacific to the Atlantic, stopping along the way to help build homes and spread the good word of the Gospel. They call their efforts "Faith in Action". There will be a special dinner for them at the Deer Lodge Assembly church, Monday evening at 6:00 pm if you would like to hear more about their journey and mission. Also, the St. Mary's Center will be completely packed with 300+ people from the Northwest for a regional 4-H conference from July 30<sup>th</sup> till August 2<sup>nd</sup>. We wish all our guests the very best.







**SACRAMENTAL INFORMATION**

**Infant Baptism:** Parents must be registered & active members of this parish or of another parish with family here in the parish (i.e., parents). Letter of permission from Pastor if parents are from outside the parish. Two Godparents who are registered and active members of their parish, one male and one female. Contact the Pastor before infant's due date to arrange date and time.

**Holy Matrimony:** Couples discerning this sacrament should contact the Pastor immediately after becoming engaged. NOTE: the diocese requires a minimum of 6 months advance notice regarding the intention to marry. Couples wishing to marry in the parish must be registered and active members of the parish, or individuals who have moved away whose parents are still active in the parish. Couples from other parishes must obtain a letter of permission to marry outside of their own parish.

**Anointing of the Sick:** Individuals who have been diagnosed as terminally or gravely ill or are preparing for invasive surgery should request this sacrament. Confession ordinarily proceeds receiving the sacrament of the sick, call the church office at 846-4114 to make arrangements.

**Adult Confirmation, Adult Baptism (RCIA), and Adult Reception into Full Communion with the Church:** If you, a family member, or a friend has not received the sacrament of confirmation, or are interested in being baptized into the Faith, or received into full communion with the Church, please contact the Pastor. Process will be discerned on an individual basis based on preparedness.
