
## Praying the Rosary



Currently we are in very good shape financially with money in the bank. We do however have some significant bills coming due in a few weeks and will be starting projects that will dip deeply into these funds.



## Looking for some Green Thumbs!

Mike Ford asked to take over maintenance on one of the circles in the Peace Garden last year and thanks to his efforts, we have a bunch of daisies and strawberries to enjoy. We have 2 additional circles that just have grass



and weeds growing in them now, that could use some TLC. If you are interested in adopting one of the circles to plant flowers or shrubs that would add some class and color to the Peace Garden, let Fr. Joe know. We have some left-over potting soil and money that could be used to pay for supplies. We will provide watering every other day and God will provide warmth and sunshine.



We are off to a good start. So far we have raised just over \$22,500 in the Convent Remodel project, so we have a ways to go to match the \$100k. Contractor bids are coming in and the money we have available will determine how quickly we can proceed with construction.



Work has begun on replacing the roof on the Old Hall. The roof has leaked on occasion and a number of shingles have been blowing off when the wind blows hard. We've entered into a 5 year lease with Child Start Inc./Head Start, so we are guaranteed to recoup our investment through the \$6,600+/yr. we will be getting in rental fees. With the new electrical meter, they will be paying for all the utilities that they use, so the parish will not be subsidizing them in any way. The eaves and windows will be getting a touchup also with new paint and rumor has it you may catch Joan Sewell up in a lift swinging a brush instead of scissors on occasion.



**SACRAMENTAL INFORMATION**

**Infant Baptism:** Parents must be registered & active members of this parish or of another parish with family here in the parish (i.e., parents). Letter of permission from Pastor if parents are from outside the parish. Two Godparents who are registered and active members of their parish, one male and one female. Contact the Pastor before infant's due date to arrange date and time.

**Holy Matrimony:** Couples discerning this sacrament should contact the Pastor immediately after becoming engaged. NOTE: the diocese requires a minimum of 6 months advance notice regarding the intention to marry. Couples wishing to marry in the parish must be registered and active members of the parish, or individuals who have moved away whose parents are still active in the parish. Couples from other parishes must obtain a letter of permission to marry outside of their own parish.

**Anointing of the Sick:** Individuals who have been diagnosed as terminally or gravely ill or are preparing for invasive surgery should request this sacrament. Confession ordinarily proceeds receiving the sacrament of the sick, call the church office at 846-4114 to make arrangements.

**Adult Confirmation, Adult Baptism (RCIA), and Adult Reception into Full Communion with the Church:** If you, a family member, or a friend has not received the sacrament of confirmation, or are interested in being baptized into the Faith, or received into full communion with the Church, please contact the Pastor. Process will be discerned on an individual basis based on preparedness.
