




What is missing from this picture? It will be dark in the Peace Park in the evenings from now on. When Fr. Joe first arrived in Deer Lodge, the lights in the Peace Park were not on and he didn't think it was an issue. A couple years later, he noticed that we were being charge \$60/mo. for these lights and had Northwestern Energy come and fix them. It was a blown fuse. After visiting with the Finance Committee recently, it was decided that we could get by without the lights and save over \$700/yr. on our utility bills. There are motion sensor lights on the shed, garage and church that provide adequate lighting if someone is in the area.

Dark brown steel siding was installed on the two parts of the convent remodel where we reclaimed some square footage for the project. The old exit area in the middle has become a large storage closet off the new large meeting room. The other area where there was a planter and exterior entrance to the chapel is now a cozy little office nook where Chris will be able to work on her weekly projects for the Church.



We still have a number of 2019 calendars available in the back of the church. Feel free to grab a second one now that everyone else has had a chance to get one.






Progress is slow on matching our grant of \$100,000. With \$39,137 raised so far we are over 1/3 of the way to meeting our matching grant goal. Unfortunately we will likely have to pause construction in January because we will

be out of money and need to wait until the matching grant funds start to catch up. It looks like we may have enough to get the drywall and heating installed, but carpeting and other finishing touches may have to wait.

With the Christmas holidays, not much progress has been made on the remodeling project. The new windows have been delivered and are waiting to be installed. After that, it will be time for the sheet-rocking and painting to commence. We may have to make an adjustment on the colors we have chosen based on the colors of the carpet squares that were available. Watch for the notice of a future meeting to finalize our flooring and color choices.



Most of the WAU Renewals have been paid, but there are still a few that we haven't received payment or notification of cancellation yet. If we don't get payment by the end of December, we will cancel your subscription so we don't end up paying for copies that are not needed.

We've got 3 new families that signed up for online giving. Two just gave Fr. Joe a voided check with instructions for weekly donations to be taken out of their checking account. The other went online and set up a monthly credit card donation. Fr. Joe will be monitoring things closely to make sure everything works as planned!



We have some tentative plans for the layout of the remodeled chapel area. We will reuse the old parish altar and make the entire front area a raised platform with a small ramp on the right side for wheelchair access. It will be done in a wood laminate and covered with Turkish rugs that Fr. Joe has available. The pews will be the ones that were removed from the church a couple of years ago with an open handicap area near the door. The floor will be done in carpet squares. So far we have no firm plans for what to do with the old windows. We can get new windows like the one shown on the right for \$10,000 each. SACRAMENTAL INFORMATION

Infant Baptism: Parents must be registered & active members of this parish or of another parish with family here in the parish (i.e., parents). Letter of permission from Pastor if parents are from outside the parish. Two Godparents who are registered and active members of their parish, one male and one female. Contact the Pastor before infant's due date to arrange date and time.

Holy Matrimony: Couples discerning this sacrament should contact the Pastor immediately after becoming engaged. NOTE: the diocese requires a minimum of 6 months advance notice regarding the intention to marry. Couples wishing to marry in the parish must be registered and active members of the parish, or individuals who have moved away whose parents are still active in the parish. Couples from other parishes must obtain a letter of permission to marry outside of their own parish.

Anointing of the Sick: Individuals who have been diagnosed as terminally or gravely ill or are preparing for invasive surgery should request this sacrament. Confession ordinarily proceeds receiving the sacrament of the sick, call the church office at 846-4114 to make arrangements.

Adult Confirmation, Adult Baptism (RCIA), and Adult Reception into Full Communion with the Church: If you, a family member, or a friend has not received the sacrament of confirmation, or are interested in being baptized into the Faith, or received into full communion with the Church, please contact the Pastor. Process will be discerned on an individual basis based on preparedness.
