







End of year reports are now available for those that may need them to do your taxes. We do our best to capture all the donations, but we may occasionally miss posting something. The date on the report is the date that it was posted to the system, not the date of the Mass. If you notice a discrepancy, give Fr. Joe a call and he will work with you to figure out what happened. With the new higher standard deduction, the IRS anticipates only 10% of the public will itemize deductions. So, rather than print all the reports in the future, we will likely have a sign up sheet and produce only the reports that are requested.

The Cross of Christ - A Lenten Retreat

This Lenten retreat will focus on the Cross of Christ, for it is only through His Cross that we can understand our Easter redemption. We will explore how the Cross teaches humility, mercy, and love – the template for living a life in Christ. And we will review how the “Greatest Commandment – to love God and one another” is fulfilled in the Cross. Finally, our time contemplating the beauty of the Cross will give us a deeper appreciation for our refrain: “We adore You O Christ, and we bless You! The sheetrock is in the process of being installed. In a couple of days, the mudding/taping will begin to cover up the cracks and imperfections in the sheetrock process. We will have to keep some heat on in the construction area so that the mud does not freeze. After a little sanding to get rid of the rough spots, it will be time to start painting. So this is the last chance to say something about the colors we have chosen. The carpet squares have been

ordered and should be available for installation when the painting is completed. We will be using track lights in all of the rooms to allow us to customize how the spaces are illuminated. There will still be a lot of other finishing work to take care of like: an ADA compliant front door, installing all the internal doors, installing all the light fixtures, installing the toilets and sinks, finishing the shower, installing the kitchen cabinets, installing the molding and trim, moving the altar and pews back into the chapel, moving the office furniture and files over from the Rectory, installing blinds and curtains, setting up the chapel for Mass, etc. As soon as we get most of these things done we will look at planning a reception for everyone to come and see the new space and an inaugural Mass in the remodeled chapel.







SACRAMENTAL INFORMATION

Infant Baptism: Parents must be registered & active members of this parish or of another parish with family here in the parish (i.e., parents). Letter of permission from Pastor if parents are from outside the parish. Two Godparents who are registered and active members of their parish, one male and one female. Contact the Pastor before infant's due date to arrange date and time.

Holy Matrimony: Couples discerning this sacrament should contact the Pastor immediately after becoming engaged. NOTE: the diocese requires a minimum of 6 months advance notice regarding the intention to marry. Couples wishing to marry in the parish must be registered and active members of the parish, or individuals who have moved away whose parents are still active in the parish. Couples from other parishes must obtain a letter of permission to marry outside of their own parish.

Anointing of the Sick: Individuals who have been diagnosed as terminally or gravely ill or are preparing for invasive surgery should request this sacrament. Confession ordinarily proceeds receiving the sacrament of the sick, call the church office at 846-4114 to make arrangements.

Adult Confirmation, Adult Baptism (RCIA), and Adult Reception into Full Communion with the Church: If you, a family member, or a friend has not received the sacrament of confirmation, or are interested in being baptized into the Faith, or received into full communion with the Church, please contact the Pastor. Process will be discerned on an individual basis based on preparedness.
