




Zoom will be sent out before the meeting using Flock-note, so watch for the special email. Zoom needs to be installed on your computer first and then you will be able to just click on a link that will be sent on Tuesday to enter into the meeting. Since it is free, we will only have 40 minutes to get our business done, so be ready.



We have soap and sanitizer in both bathrooms in the IC Church plus an automatic dispenser above the holy water fountain on the right side as you enter. Just hold

If you haven't been to one of our recent Masses, you may be surprised by the blue masking tape on the pews. In order to minimize the disinfecting of pews after Mass we need people to fill up the church from the front. We will have ushers that will direct people to these pews and help insure that proper social distances are maintained. If additional rows need to be open, the usher will remove the tape and let people in. 

**SACRAMENTAL INFORMATION**

**Infant Baptism:** Parents must be registered & active members of this parish or of another parish with family here in the parish (i.e., parents). Letter of permission from Pastor if parents are from outside the parish. Two Godparents who are registered and active members of their parish, one male and one female. Contact the Pastor before infant's due date to arrange date and time.

**Holy Matrimony:** Couples discerning this sacrament should contact the Pastor immediately after becoming engaged. NOTE: the diocese requires a minimum of 6 months advance notice regarding the intention to marry. Couples wishing to marry in the parish must be registered and active members of the parish, or individuals who have moved away whose parents are still active in the parish. Couples from other parishes must obtain a letter of permission to marry outside of their own parish.

**Anointing of the Sick:** Individuals who have been diagnosed as terminally or gravely ill or are preparing for invasive surgery should request this sacrament. Confession ordinarily proceeds receiving the sacrament of the sick, call the church office at 846-4114 to make arrangements.

**Adult Confirmation, Adult Baptism (RCIA), and Adult Reception into Full Communion with the Church:** If you, a family member, or a friend has not received the sacrament of confirmation, or are interested in being baptized into the Faith, or received into full communion with the Church, please contact the Pastor. Process will be discerned on an individual basis based on preparedness.
