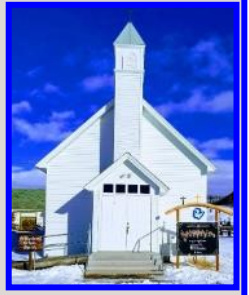


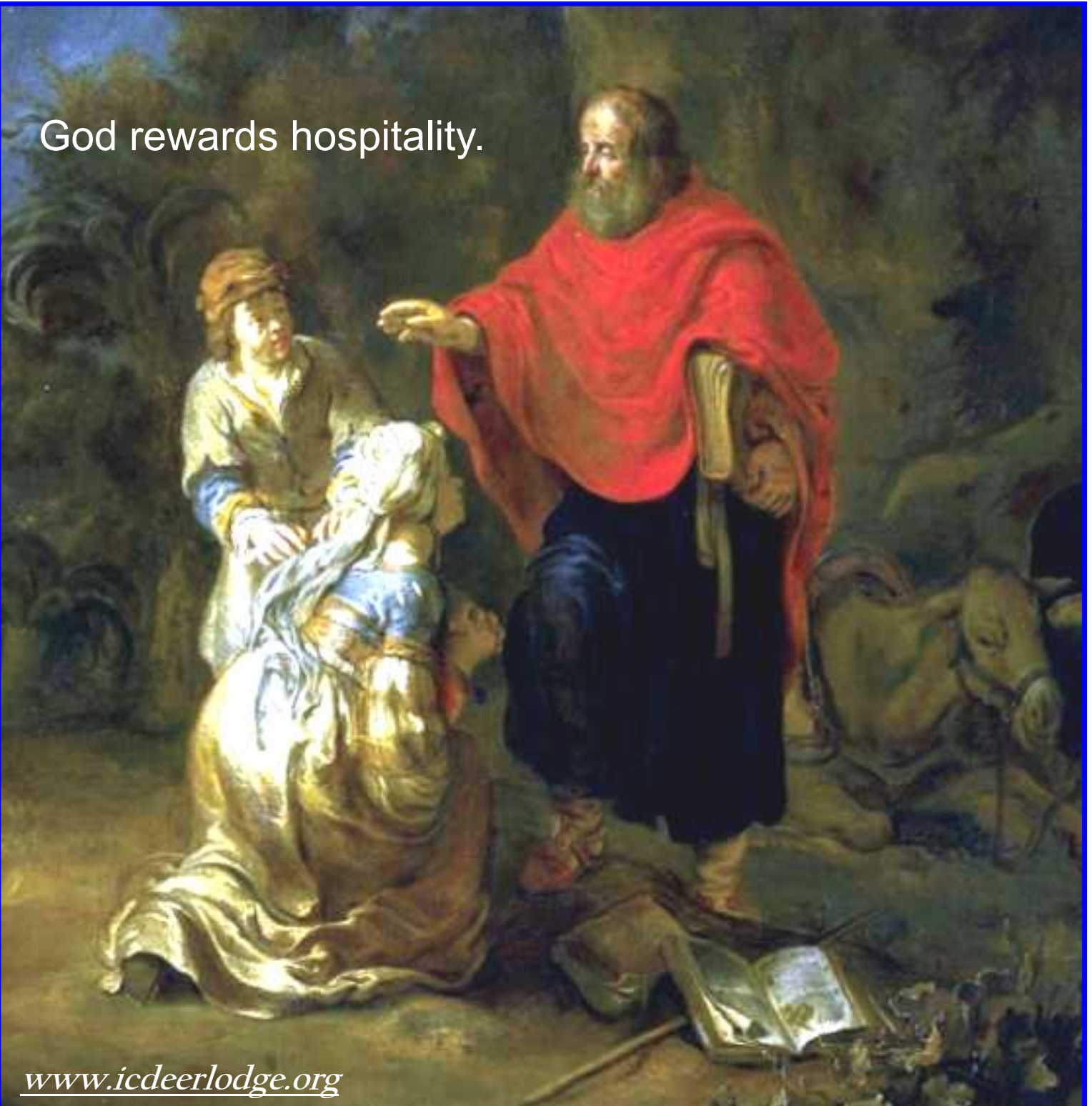

We will be looking for volunteers to be lectors from those attending each service. Eucharistic Ministers will not be needed during the covid-19 pandemic.

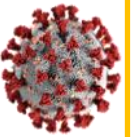

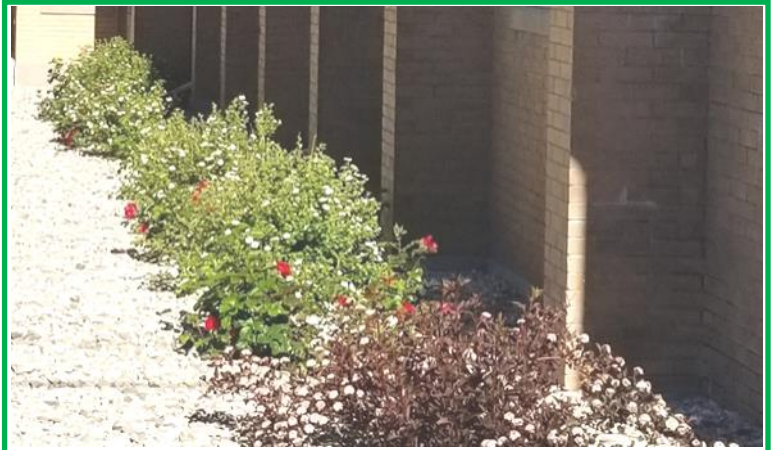
May mothers receive ongoing care and support in raising their children.

The Church is encouraging special prayers this month for Mothers in dealing with the challenges of raising their children. Since we are limited in what we can do out in the world socially due to the corona virus, it provides an opportunity to use some of that time for prayer.

The Diocese has mandated that all parishes use QuickBooks (QB) in the "Cloud" for their accounting system. This will force a standardization of bookkeeping practices that will allow the Bishop to see at a glance the financial health of our Diocese, Although we are financially in good shape, there are a number of other parishes that are struggling to make ends meet. We will start using the new system starting July 1st, the beginning of our new fiscal year. It will take some getting used to as we figure out what categories to code expenses to. Our accountants, Newland and Co. are very familiar with QB so the conversion shouldn't be that difficult for them. The challenge will be for Fr. Joe learning how to do all the reporting and other functions that he was used to doing.



The warm weather has put everything into high bloom. The potentillas are winning the blooming race, but it looks like the roses are getting ready to bust out in full force. As the sun starts to shine more, God's beauty will be busting out all over.

For the past few years we have been making incremental improvements in our Church property. Fr. Joe is looking for people to help with a number of projects around the property.

One of the projects would be to replace the



cracking and aging plastic edging around the Old School. It would need to be dug up and replaced with landscaping timbers. So digging, cutting timbers and driving spikes would be involved. A minimum 3 person crew would probably be needed to make things go smoothly. The other project would be to clean up the corner of the school, putting in landscaping timbers to provide an edge and then laying down weed barrier and moving in some rocks. If we get big crews to work on these projects, there are a couple of smaller projects like fixing the



handicap signs with some edging and cement to hold them in place. The Church will provide all the materials, we just need some helping hands.



SACRAMENTAL INFORMATION

Infant Baptism: Parents must be registered & active members of this parish or of another parish with family here in the parish (i.e., parents). Letter of permission from Pastor if parents are from outside the parish. Two Godparents who are registered and active members of their parish, one male and one female. Contact the Pastor before infant's due date to arrange date and time.

Holy Matrimony: Couples discerning this sacrament should contact the Pastor immediately after becoming engaged. NOTE: the diocese requires a minimum of 6 months advance notice regarding the intention to marry. Couples wishing to marry in the parish must be registered and active members of the parish, or individuals who have moved away whose parents are still active in the parish. Couples from other parishes must obtain a letter of permission to marry outside of their own parish.

Anointing of the Sick: Individuals who have been diagnosed as terminally or gravely ill or are preparing for invasive surgery should request this sacrament. Confession ordinarily proceeds receiving the sacrament of the sick, call the church office at 846-4114 to make arrangements.

Adult Confirmation, Adult Baptism (RCIA), and Adult Reception into Full Communion with the Church: If you, a family member, or a friend has not received the sacrament of confirmation, or are interested in being baptized into the Faith, or received into full communion with the Church, please contact the Pastor. Process will be discerned on an individual basis based on preparedness.
