# UNITED STATES CONFERENCE OF CATHOLIC BISHOPS

The USCCB has put out a letter regarding the moral concerns in the preparation of the covid-19 vaccines that will be distributed in the coming weeks. The cliff notes version is that the Pfizer and Moderna vaccines have been developed using some compromised cell lines, but overall community well being from having a working vaccine to protect the public, mitigates the limited usage of compromised cells. The AstraZeneca vaccine on the other hand used a more significant amount of compromised cells in the development and production of their vaccine and conscientious Catholics are being encourage to select the Pfizer or Moderna vaccines if at all possible when they get vaccinated. 

SACRAMENTAL INFORMATION



**Holy Matrimony:** Couples discerning this sacrament should contact the Pastor immediately after becoming engaged. NOTE: the diocese requires a minimum of 6 months advance notice regarding the intention to marry. Couples wishing to marry in the parish must be registered and active members of the parish, or individuals who have moved away whose parents are still active in the parish. Couples from other parishes must obtain a letter of permission to marry outside of their own parish.

**Anointing of the Sick:** Individuals who have been diagnosed as terminally or gravely ill or are preparing for invasive surgery should request this sacrament. Confession ordinarily proceeds receiving the sacrament of the sick, call the church office at 846-4114 to make arrangements.

Adult Confirmation, Adult Baptism (RCIA), and Adult Reception into Full **Communion with the Church:** If you, a family member, or a friend has not received the sacrament of confirmation, or are interested in being baptized into the Faith, or received into full communion with the Church, please contact the Pastor. Process will be discerned on an individual basis based on preparedness.
