Fr. Joe went over to East Helena on Tuesday with his brother Gerry to pick up Nicholas' remains. The remains were still warm and it felt like a warm hug as they were handed to Fr. Joe. They went to the Condo and did a little cleanup, getting rid of the garbage and grabbing a few items that could be used right away. He had 5 big bottles of Tums from Costco, so does anyone need some Tums? The rest, his clothes, Anime DVDs and collectables will have to wait until Nathan comes back from Washington State and can go through them. Right now, Nathan is in Clarkston, WA, staying with his mom and has expressed an interest in possibly moving to Washington, getting a job and settling down there. He has a bunch of cousins close to his own age as well as Aunts and Uncles in the area that would be there to support him as he learns to live without his brother. Only time will tell though as he also has a number of supportive friends in Helena. Either way, he will need to go through his brother's things and sort out what he wants to keep, what should be sold and what will be donated to the Good Samaritan Thrift Store. In the meantime, Fr. Joe will have the shower where he committed suicide torn out and replaced. If he decides to move to Washington, Fr. Joe will get volunteers for a cleanup crew to go through the condo top to bottom, hauling things away and doing a deep cleaning to prepare it for sale. So for now, things should be fairly calm and Fr. Joe will have a chance to process his loss with lots of prayer and good fellowship. Thank You to all who have sent cards and have been praying for him and his family.

On the Mother front, his mom Mary Ann has been placed on the waiting list for Renaissance and last time we checked there were 4 people ahead of her. The hospital got some good nutrition in her and sent her back to her home where his brother Fred will be looking in on her until she moves. She seems committed to moving to Deer Lodge, but only time will tell if that commitment remains firm or not. She has waived in the past.



SACRAMENTAL INFORMATION

Infant Baptism: Parents must be registered & active members of this parish or of another parish with family here in the parish (i.e., parents). Letter of permission from Pastor if parents are from outside the parish. Two Godparents who are registered and active members of their parish, one male and one female. Contact the Pastor before infant's due date to arrange date and time.

Holy Matrimony: Couples discerning this sacrament should contact the Pastor immediately after becoming engaged. NOTE: the diocese requires a minimum of 6 months advance notice regarding the intention to marry. Couples wishing to marry in the parish must be registered and active members of the parish, or individuals who have moved away whose parents are still active in the parish. Couples from other parishes must obtain a letter of permission to marry outside of their own parish.

Anointing of the Sick: Individuals who have been diagnosed as terminally or gravely ill or are preparing for invasive surgery should request this sacrament. Confession ordinarily proceeds receiving the sacrament of the sick, call the church office at 846-4114 to make arrangements.

Adult Confirmation, Adult Baptism (RCIA), and Adult Reception into Full Communion with the Church: If you, a family member, or a friend has not received the sacrament of confirmation, or are interested in being baptized into the Faith, or received into full communion with the Church, please contact the Pastor. Process will be discerned on an individual basis based on preparedness.
