

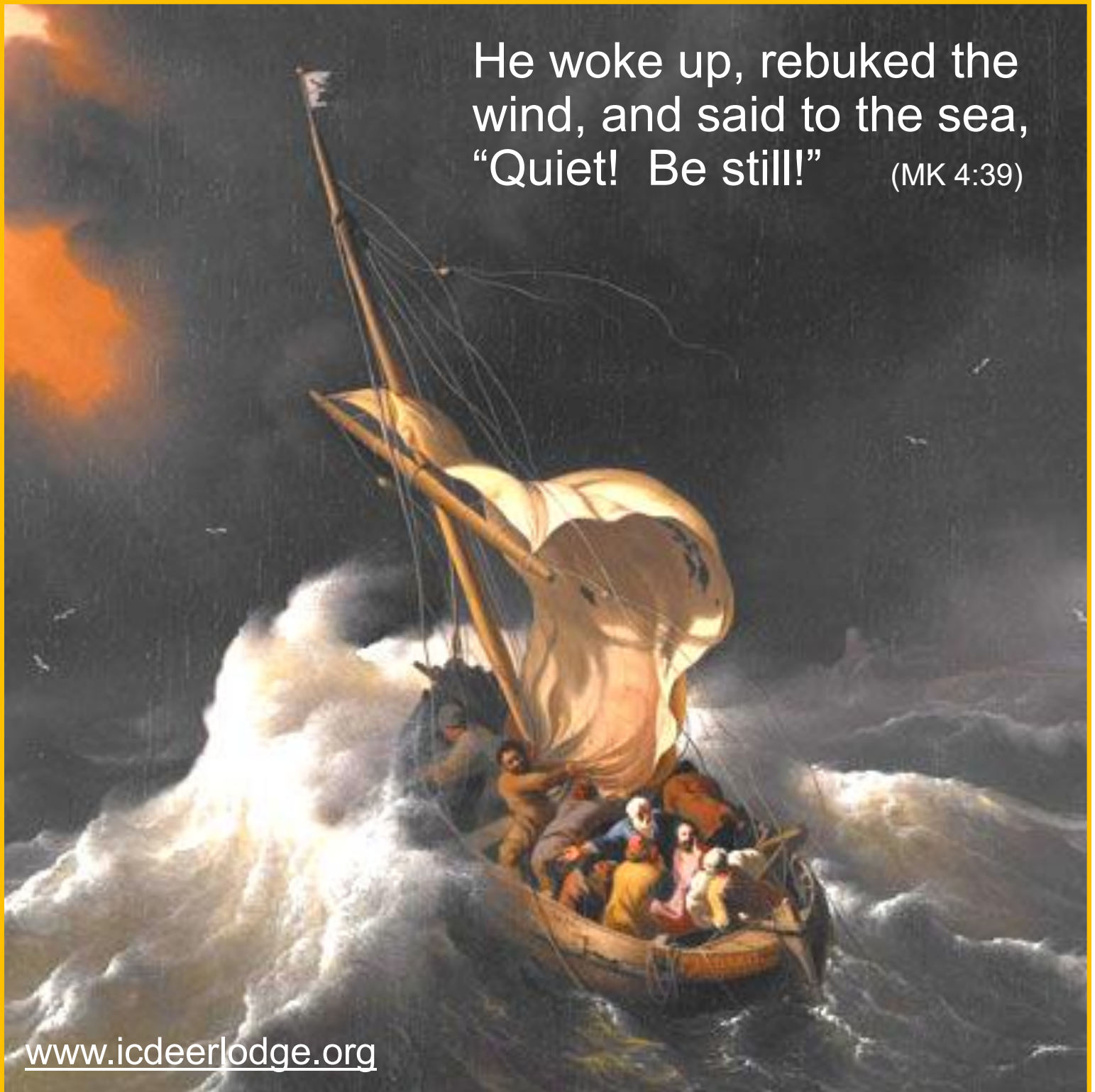

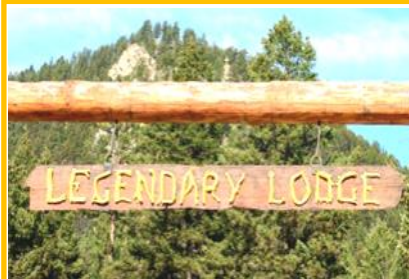

Legendary Lodge camps start this coming week with the Leadership Camp. Sara, & Natalie Spring will be attending along with Joan Sewell. Please be sure to keep them in your prayers.



The Knights of Columbus made a very generous donation of \$700 to help pay for Legendary Lodge expenses this Summer for the youth of the parish. Fr. Joe will get reimbursement checks made out to the families that send their children to one of the camps. The Knights also spent \$476 on the Mother's day breakfast and donated \$200 to help pay for sprinkler system supplies. With over 100 sprinkler heads, we lose a few each year to freezing and getting hit by mower blades. The Knights reimbursed the parish \$310 for repairs to the convection ovens and another \$25 to Tom Christnacht for a relay to fix the remaining oven. They all work now, so we can handle a big dinner if we get something lined up. The Knights finished the year with hamburgers, brats, beans and potato salad cooked up by Hal Loomis. He also baked some excellent rhubarb crisp. Fr. Joe inadvertently sent out a Flocknote to the whole parish instead of just the Knights, reminding them of the dinner. We had a couple of people show up thinking it was a special party they may have missed. We still had lots of beans and potato salad leftovers. Thank You Hal and all the Knights for all of your work this year. We will see you again the 3<sup>rd</sup> Tuesday of September when we start up again.

**SACRAMENTAL INFORMATION**

**Infant Baptism:** Parents must be registered & active members of this parish or of another parish with family here in the parish (i.e., parents). Letter of permission from Pastor if parents are from outside the parish. Two Godparents who are registered and active members of their parish, one male and one female. Contact the Pastor before infant's due date to arrange date and time.

**Holy Matrimony:** Couples discerning this sacrament should contact the Pastor immediately after becoming engaged. NOTE: the diocese requires a minimum of 6 months advance notice regarding the intention to marry. Couples wishing to marry in the parish must be registered and active members of the parish, or individuals who have moved away whose parents are still active in the parish. Couples from other parishes must obtain a letter of permission to marry outside of their own parish.

**Anointing of the Sick:** Individuals who have been diagnosed as terminally or gravely ill or are preparing for invasive surgery should request this sacrament. Confession ordinarily proceeds receiving the sacrament of the sick, call the church office at 846-4114 to make arrangements.

**Adult Confirmation, Adult Baptism (RCIA), and Adult Reception into Full Communion with the Church:** If you, a family member, or a friend has not received the sacrament of confirmation, or are interested in being baptized into the Faith, or received into full communion with the Church, please contact the Pastor. Process will be discerned on an individual basis based on preparedness.
