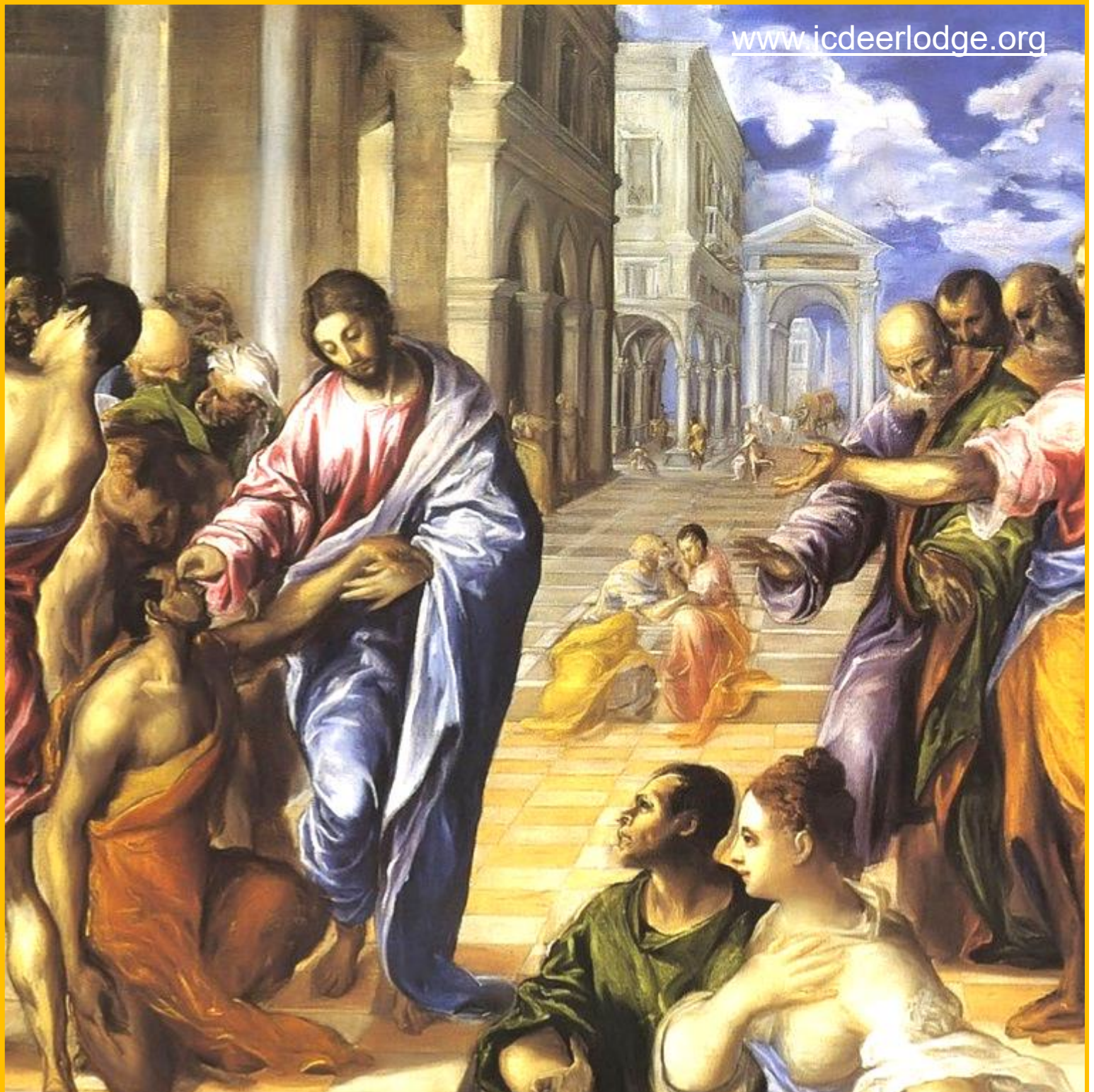

We now have 14 seminarians in formation in Denver and Minnesota. The Lord willing, Dcn. Matthew Christians and Dcn. Tyler Frohlich will be ordained to the priesthood next June and we will be able to bring some relief to priests that are stretched thing managing multiple parishes. 6 of the seminarians are just starting out with a Spirituality year, so it could be 7 years before we see them in a parish role. After the Spirituality year, they have two years of Philosophy unless they studied it in their undergraduate years. That is following by 4 years of Theology. At \$50k a year, it will cost approximately \$350,000 to get someone ready for priesthood. This will entail many long hours of studies as well as prayer. The attrition rate or discernment will lead at least a few of the young men to decide that priesthood is not for them and that is all-right. They often go on to other ways of serving in lay roles in the church. Please be sure to keep these young men and all young people in your prayers as they discern and pursue their vocations in life. They will be praying for all of you.

SACRAMENTAL INFORMATION

Infant Baptism: Parents must be registered & active members of this parish or of another parish with family here in the parish (i.e., parents). Letter of permission from Pastor if parents are from outside the parish. Two Godparents who are registered and active members of their parish, one male and one female. Contact the Pastor before infant's due date to arrange date and time.

Holy Matrimony: Couples discerning this sacrament should contact the Pastor immediately after becoming engaged. NOTE: the diocese requires a minimum of 6 months advance notice regarding the intention to marry. Couples wishing to marry in the parish must be registered and active members of the parish, or individuals who have moved away whose parents are still active in the parish. Couples from other parishes must obtain a letter of permission to marry outside of their own parish.

Anointing of the Sick: Individuals who have been diagnosed as terminally or gravely ill or are preparing for invasive surgery should request this sacrament. Confession ordinarily proceeds receiving the sacrament of the sick, call the church office at 846-4114 to make arrangements.

Adult Confirmation, Adult Baptism (RCIA), and Adult Reception into Full Communion with the Church: If you, a family member, or a friend has not received the sacrament of confirmation, or are interested in being baptized into the Faith, or received into full communion with the Church, please contact the Pastor. Process will be discerned on an individual basis based on preparedness.
