Legendary Lodge is now open for Summer Camp reservations. Unfortunately most of the more popular camps are already fully booked. They do have a waiting list that doesn't cost any money to register for that will let you know if a position comes open.

Things are moving forward for the Diocese to have major Capital Campaign. The initial goals will to raise \$9 million (mm) for Strengthening Our Parishes, \$8 mm for Growing Vocations, \$4 mm for Caring for our Retired Priests, \$4.5 mm for Evangelization, \$1.5 mm for Renewing the Cathedral. More details to follow.



The Annual Catholic Appeal (ACA) is continuing to do well. Immaculate Conception has reached 119% or \$32,863 of the \$27,700 goal. This is with 46% participation. Saint Theodore is at 138% or \$4,685 of the \$3,400 goal with 56% participation. Thank you everyone for your generous support of the ACA. With less than half of our congregation participating, we still have room to grow and show our support for the programs of our Diocese. Please give some serious thought to making a pledge.

The old cooler in the Saint Mary's Center is being removed to make room for a new cooler. We still have to get the coolant removed before we can bring in the new unit. It will be used to support having a wet bar for when the Center is rented out to others.
