





We have some furniture left over from Fr. Joe's Mother's estate that we need to find homes for. There are queen and full size bed sets with frames and bedding available. There is also a full size sofa from her house that saw very little usage. We have a white TV stand that was left over from a prior garage sale effort that is still looking for a home. We have upcoming dinners planned starting on March 18th that we would like to have things cleared out for so the renters can set up the space for their events. The items are free to anyone that is willing to haul them away, but a free will offering will be gladly accepted if they provide any value for you. Just give Fr. Joe a call at the Rectory to arrange a time to come by and take a closer look at these items and a couple of other pieces of furniture you may be interested in.



A few years back Fr. Joe got some estimates for new stained glass windows in the chapel of the Spiritual Life Center. It would be nice to have some more colorful windows in the chapel going forward with better insulating properties. Since the initial bid 5 years ago, the prices have more than doubled and the total cost would be \$60,000 to \$76,000. Fr. Joe is considering using some of the money from his Mother's Estate to sponsor the windows and was wondering if anyone else would like to join in. If you are interested in participating, let Fr. Fr. Joe has made arrangements with a service firm in Missoula to replace our broken and aging chemical equipment on our dishwasher with a new more environmentally friendly system. The firm provides regular service on the equipment and our only commitment is to buy the cleaning supplies from them. Based on our normal usage it will cost us less than \$100/yr. for this new service. The goal will be to have the new equipment up and running in time for the March 18th Black Tie Dinner.

Once again the FDOH is paying out its quarterly dividend that is a nice little boost to help pay all our various bills. Immaculate Conception received \$973 and St. Theodore received \$96. SACRAMENTAL INFORMATION

Infant Baptism: Parents must be registered & active members of this parish or of another parish with family here in the parish (i.e., parents). Letter of permission from Pastor if parents are from outside the parish. Two Godparents who are registered and active members of their parish, one male and one female. Contact the Pastor before infant's due date to arrange date and time.

Holy Matrimony: Couples discerning this sacrament should contact the Pastor immediately after becoming engaged. NOTE: the diocese requires a minimum of 6 months advance notice regarding the intention to marry. Couples wishing to marry in the parish must be registered and active members of the parish, or individuals who have moved away whose parents are still active in the parish. Couples from other parishes must obtain a letter of permission to marry outside of their own parish.

Anointing of the Sick: Individuals who have been diagnosed as terminally or gravely ill or are preparing for invasive surgery should request this sacrament. Confession ordinarily proceeds receiving the sacrament of the sick, call the church office at 846-4114 to make arrangements.

Adult Confirmation, Adult Baptism (RCIA), and Adult Reception into Full Communion with the Church: If you, a family member, or a friend has not received the sacrament of confirmation, or are interested in being baptized into the Faith, or received into full communion with the Church, please contact the Pastor. Process will be discerned on an individual basis based on preparedness.
