
We have a backlog of just over 100 Masses that need to be celebrated with more requests coming in every week. Some of the requests are almost one year old. Fr. Joe is only allowed by Canon Law to celebrate one Mass per day. That means it will be over 20

weeks until he can satisfy all the requests we already have. If you request a Mass now, it may be several months before he can get around to celebrating it. We have the option of "farming out" the masses to monasteries and foreign missions to give them some additional income. When we receive a number of requests for one individual, we spread those out over many weeks and sometimes months giving preference to the most recently deceased. Another option other than individual Masses is contributing a Memorial for the individual which we will publish in the bulletin. We will be discussing our options and let you know what we decide to do.


Make a Holy Moment

SACRAMENTAL INFORMATION

Infant Baptism: Parents must be registered & active members of this parish or of another parish with family here in the parish (i.e., parents). Letter of permission from Pastor if parents are from outside the parish. Two Godparents who are registered and active members of their parish, one male and one female. Contact the Pastor before infant's due date to arrange date and time.

Holy Matrimony: Couples discerning this sacrament should contact the Pastor immediately after becoming engaged. NOTE: the diocese requires a minimum of 6 months advance notice regarding the intention to marry. Couples wishing to marry in the parish must be registered and active members of the parish, or individuals who have moved away whose parents are still active in the parish. Couples from other parishes must obtain a letter of permission to marry outside of their own parish.

Anointing of the Sick: Individuals who have been diagnosed as terminally or gravely ill or are preparing for invasive surgery should request this sacrament. Confession ordinarily proceeds receiving the sacrament of the sick, call the church office at 846-4114 to make arrangements.

Adult Confirmation, Adult Baptism (RCIA), and Adult Reception into Full Communion with the Church: If you, a family member, or a friend has not received the sacrament of confirmation, or are interested in being baptized into the Faith, or received into full communion with the Church, please contact the Pastor. Process will be discerned on an individual basis based on preparedness.
