We had a little mix up with the City of Deer Lodge as to who is supposed the sell plots in the Catholic sections. We are the only church in town that actually owns the land that we bury people in. We have 4.7 acres total with much of it still available. The city sold 26 burial plots in our areas over the last few years for a total of \$9,100. During this time we have been paying them \$3,000 a year to maintain our areas in the cemetery. So we will be asking for the money back or a 3 year moratorium on maintenance fees. In the mean time, if you would like to purchase a burial plot, they are \$350 each. We may have to raise prices in the near future to cover the increased cost of maintaining the cemetery property. Many families buy a group of plots at one time so they can insure that everyone will be buried in the same area. The funeral homes should know about this arrangement if you are working through them, but just in case you may want to remind them when you make arrangements .
