Funeral Masses will generally be held at 11:00 a.m. and the 8:00 a.m. Mass that day will be cancelled.



We will be doing the annual Parish Census counts the next 3 weekends in our parishes across the Diocese. IC's numbers have gone down 32% since 2014 and St. Theo's have gone up 17%. Hopefully we be able to fill the church more than usual the next few weeks.

Fr. Joe has scheduled this Fall's RCIA classes starting Wednesday, October 11<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 pm until 8:30 pm. They will occur every 2 weeks on Wednesday evening and are open to anyone interested in learning more about our Catholic faith or possible joining our Church. Please give Fr. Joe at call at 846-4114 if you are interested so he can get you registered. If you know of anyone else that may be interested in this, let them know about the classes and have them call Fr. Joe if they have any specific questions. This is a great way to fill in those gaps you may have about your Catholic faith.

Fr. Joe met with the City Council on Monday night to discuss the cemetery situation. It was agreed that to simplify things, the City will be responsible for the sale of all plots going forward and take care of all maintenance costs. This will free Immaculate Conception from the responsibility of assigning and selling plots as well as paying the quarterly maintenance fees of \$750 or \$3,000 per year. The City will be looking at potentially adjusting the cost of a plot and associated fees upward to allow them to cover their annual maintenance costs. The City and IC have not raised the \$350/plot fee for over 10 vears while the cost of most things have doubled or tripled. Most other cities charge \$1,000/plot or more for a plot. We will be formalizing the arrangements with actual contracts or agreements that will be kept on file to eliminate any confusion in the future. It will take a few weeks to finalize all the arrangements, but plan on making any future cemetery plot purchases through your mortuary or directly with the city.
