

Most of our parishioners have been visited and have the materials in their possession to make a decision on how much they can support this effort. We just need for them to turn in the commitment forms to let us know what they are willing to pledge. We realize that times are difficult for many families with fixed incomes, medical expenses, college tuition and all the other things that gnaw away at what we have to spend. If we put God first though and tithe as He has asked us to, to the Church and other charities, God has a way of making it up to us. God is not stingy with what he gives us, let's not be stingy with what we give Him.



We have a new poster for our 12 seminarians available in the back of the church. We are down 3 from last year but recruiting efforts are ongoing. Please remember to keep these young men in your prayers to give them perseverance on their journey to priesthood. Also prayer for our Bishop and our new vocation director Fr. Chris.

This may be your last chance to buy a cemetery plot for \$350. The City will be taking over the responsibility for selling and maintaining the Catholic sections now so we don't have to pay the \$3,000/year maintenance fee. They will keep the price of a plot at \$350 until the end of October. They may or may not raise the fee after that. Most other cemeteries charge around \$1,000/plot.

SACRAMENTAL INFORMATION

Infant Baptism: Parents must be registered & active members of this parish or of another parish with family here in the parish (i.e., parents). Letter of permission from Pastor if parents are from outside the parish. Two Godparents who are registered and active members of their parish, one male and one female. Contact the Pastor before infant's due date to arrange date and time.

Holy Matrimony: Couples discerning this sacrament should contact the Pastor immediately after becoming engaged. NOTE: the diocese requires a minimum of 6 months advance notice regarding the intention to marry. Couples wishing to marry in the parish must be registered and active members of the parish, or individuals who have moved away whose parents are still active in the parish. Couples from other parishes must obtain a letter of permission to marry outside of their own parish.

Anointing of the Sick: Individuals who have been diagnosed as terminally or gravely ill or are preparing for invasive surgery should request this sacrament. Confession ordinarily proceeds receiving the sacrament of the sick, call the church office at 846-4114 to make arrangements.

Adult Confirmation, Adult Baptism (RCIA), and Adult Reception into Full Communion with the Church: If you, a family member, or a friend has not received the sacrament of confirmation, or are interested in being baptized into the Faith, or received into full communion with the Church, please contact the Pastor. Process will be discerned on an individual basis based on preparedness.
