

We are in the process of moving to a new Online-Giving vendor, Give Central. Unfortunately, this will require setting things up on their system in the coming weeks. We will do everything we can to minimize the effort by populating fields with the necessary infor-

mation, but you will need to re-enter your credit card or bank account information. Those items are always protected so they can't be stolen. You will only have to enter them once after which they will be available to reuse. If you are not using Online-Giving, now may be a good time to consider giving it a try.

We have finished the first phase of upgrading to the new parish management software. According the documentation, it was created especially for Catholic churches. All current information has been migrated over and additional infor-



mation is being added. The company has been very good about fixing problems and helping us to learn the new systems. One of the ad-ons to the new system is the Evangelus system which we have started using to send out the weekly bulletin and messages.





Once that is done, Fr. Joe will start displaying and handing out the Annual Catholic Campaign (ACA) literature. Many people have already responded to this fundraising effort when they received the envelopes that were mailed out a couple of weeks ago. This ACA campaign for \$2 million is necessary to fund all the Diocesan programs still ongoing during this year like the \$500k that is needed for Seminarian Education. It will also fund the "Encountering Love" efforts for evangelization.

SACRAMENTAL INFORMATION

Infant Baptism: Parents must be registered & active members of this parish or of another parish with family here in the parish (i.e., parents). Letter of permission from Pastor if parents are from outside the parish. Two Godparents who are registered and active members of their parish, one male and one female. Contact the Pastor before infant's due date to arrange date and time.

Holy Matrimony: Couples discerning this sacrament should contact the Pastor immediately after becoming engaged. NOTE: the diocese requires a minimum of 6 months advance notice regarding the intention to marry. Couples wishing to marry in the parish must be registered and active members of the parish, or individuals who have moved away whose parents are still active in the parish. Couples from other parishes must obtain a letter of permission to marry outside of their own parish.

Anointing of the Sick: Individuals who have been diagnosed as terminally or gravely ill or are preparing for invasive surgery should request this sacrament. Confession ordinarily proceeds receiving the sacrament of the sick, call the church office at 846-4114 to make arrangements.

Adult Confirmation, Adult Baptism (RCIA), and Adult Reception into Full Communion with the Church: If you, a family member, or a friend has not received the sacrament of confirmation, or are interested in being baptized into the Faith, or received into full communion with the Church, please contact the Pastor. Process will be discerned on an individual basis based on preparedness.
