

Once again Thank You to everyone that participated in the Capital Campaign. Immaculate Conception Parish raised \$450,310 in pledges to achieve 174% of our goal. That means we will have \$224,486 coming back to our parish over the course of the next 5 years. St. Theodore Mission raised \$101,600 and achieved 502% of their goal. They will have \$81,376 coming back to them over the next 5 years. There may still be a few pledges that come in as they check on online donations that may have been made through the Campaign website. A final tally will be provided in the coming weeks after all the numbers are in.

Our focus has now turned to the **Annual Capital Campaign (ACA)** to support the programs of the Diocese. Posters, envelopes and brochures with more information will be in the back of he Church. You should have received a direct mailing for the ACA, but just incase you may have missed getting the information or lost it, we will keep these available for the duration of the ACA.
