

The Annual Catholic Appeal (ACA) is active and you should get another letter from the Bishop soon asking you to participate.








We also have two parishioners planning on taking the Journey. Christina Dickson will be attending this weekend and Tim Heiydt will be going on the men's weekend. His wife Dawn will be working the kitchen that week also. Please remember to keep them all in your prayers.,

The architects came up with three different potential elevations for an addition to the church. The primary goals were to get bathroom(s), a good ramp and coverage to get into the church, a gathering space and to keep the overall cost as low as possible. If you compare closely, you will see that the primary difference is the rooflines and how they blend into the existing church. The more complicated the roofline the more costly the construction though. All three have the same basic interior plan with 1,000 sq. feet of usable space and two bathrooms. The window configurations can be more easily changed to be whatever we want. Knocking down the one wall and extending the space created some technical, liturgical and code issues so we had them focus on creating a new building and connecting the spaces. To get water we will either have to drill a well or get a cistern system. Because the lot is so small, we will likely have to put in a sewage pit and have it pumped regularly because there is not enough room for a drainage field. We will have a meeting shortly to discuss the options.

#### SACRAMENTAL INFORMATION

Infant Baptism: Parents must be registered & active members of this parish or of another parish with family here in the parish (i.e., parents). Letter of permission from Pastor if parents are from outside the parish. Two Godparents who are registered and active members of their parish, one male and one female. Contact the Pastor before infant's due date to arrange date and time.

Holy Matrimony: Couples discerning this sacrament should contact the Pastor immediately after becoming engaged. NOTE: the diocese requires a minimum of 6 months advance notice regarding the intention to marry. Couples wishing to marry in the parish must be registered and active members of the parish, or individuals who have moved away whose parents are still active in the parish. Couples from other parishes must obtain a letter of permission to marry outside of their own parish.

Anointing of the Sick: Individuals who have been diagnosed as terminally or gravely ill or are preparing for invasive surgery should request this sacrament. Confession ordinarily proceeds receiving the sacrament of the sick, call the church office at 846-4114 to make arrangements.

Adult Confirmation, Adult Baptism (RCIA), and Adult Reception into Full Communion with the Church: If you, a family member, or a friend has not received the sacrament of confirmation, or are interested in being baptized into the Faith, or received into full communion with the Church, please contact the Pastor. Process will be discerned on an individual basis based on preparedness.
